



City of Bastrop Emergency Water Line Replacement

A special meeting was held by City Council on July 19, 2010 and Emergency Action to replace one of the two water lines that supply water from the Willow water treatment plant, located just North of Fisherman's Park, to the Loop 150 tank yard which is across from the American Legion was approved.

This aging 8-inch water line has continued to fail and will be replaced as well as up-sized to a 12-inch line, which will increase the pumping capacity. The work will begin at MLK and Pine Street, traveling East on Pine Street, going under Highway 95 to Loop 150 and continue east up the hill to the Loop 150 tank yard.

Befco Engineering is designing the project and Cunningham Construction & Associates will be the contractors. The contract is for 90 days, and since this is an emergency project, the contractor will have three crews installing pipe to speed up the process.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused. Appropriate safeguards and water utility services have been restored to homeowners affected.
