## ORDINANCE NO. R-2022-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS DECLARING MEASURES MOOT IN THE MAY 7, 2022, SPECIAL ELECTION ON CHARTER AMENDMENTS; CANCELING THE ELECTION, AS EXHIBIT A; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, on February 8, 2022, the City of Bastrop called for a special election to be held on May 7, 2022, for the purpose of amending the Home Rule Charter; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has statutory authority to cancel a special election on a measure pursuant to Texas Election Code §2.081 when a proposition is essentially moot; and
- WHEREAS, according to Black's Law Dictionary a matter is moot when it cannot have any practical effect on a situation, there is no existing controversy, no actual issues exist, and the items involved are academic in nature; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the special election ordered for May 2022, to be moot; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council prefers to delay an election on any charter amendments until such time as there are other races or propositions on the ballot so to achieve administrative efficiency, fiscal accountability, and greater voter participation; and
- WHEREAS, all constitutional and statutory prerequisites for the approval of this ordinance have been met, including but not limited to the Open Meetings Act; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council finds this ordinance to be reasonable and necessary under the circumstances; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council deems the adoption of this ordinance to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

- **Section 1.** That all matters stated hereinabove are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference as if copied in their entirety.
  - **Section 2.** The May 7, 2022, City of Bastrop Special Election is canceled.
- **Section 3.** The City Secretary is directed to post a copy of the Order of Cancellation attached as Exhibit "A" at each designated polling location on May 7, 2022.

<u>Section 4.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
