CLIMATE POLLUTION REDUCTION GRANT

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF BASTROP A LETTER SUPPORTING THE CITY OF AUSTIN IN ITS APPLICATION FOR A CLIMATE POLLUTION REDUCTION PLANNING GRANT

- WHEREAS, the City of Austin would like the City of Bastrop to support their application to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a Climate Pollution Reduction Planning Grant (CPRG) in the amount of \$1 million; and
- WHEREAS, the grant is open to governmental and planning entities and is aimed to support pollution reduction by supporting the development and deployment of technologies and solutions that will reduce harmful air pollution; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City of Austin will take the lead in managing the grant and providing resources to meet the grant requirements; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop intends to participate in those activities and the development of those deliverables, led by the City of Austin; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council of the City of Bastrop ("City Council") finds it to be in the public interest, and necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, to approve this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bastrop:

- **Section 1:** The City Council hereby states its support of the City of Austin's application to participate in the CPRG Planning Grant program.
- Section 2: The City Council designates the City of Austin with oversight and responsibility for managing grant funds and coordinating activities and deliverables pertaining to the CPRG Planning Grant program.
- **Section 3:** The City Council declares its intention to participate in those activities and the development of those deliverables, led by the City of Austin.
- **Section 4:** The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to submit a letter of support on behalf of the City of Bastrop in furtherance of the City of Austin's grant application.

Section 5: The meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act.
