## RESOLUTION NO. R 2015-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS TO ADOPT 44 CFR 13.16 AS THE STANDARD PROCUREMENT POLICY FOR THE CITY OF BASTROP FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF HAZARDOUS MITIGATION SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bastrop desires to enter a grant and funding relationship with the Texas Division of Emergency Management for Hazard Mitigation projects.

WHEREAS, FEMA, through 44 CFR 13.16, requires the agency receiving the grant to utilize the most stringent procurement policies whether it be federal, state or local.

WHEREAS, this procurement policy may, at times, be more stringent than the current purchasing policy as the State does not require use of a competitive process for selection of professional services, but the federal regulations do require it.

WHEREAS, this is the last requirement of our last project audit with Texas Division of Emergency Management.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

That the City Council of the City of Bastrop approves adopting 44 CFR 13.16 as the standard procurement policy for the procurement of Hazard Mitigation Services.
