RFQ FOR ENGINEERING & SURVEYING

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR **ENGINEERING** AND SURVEYING SERVICES **FOR** INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS INCLUDING (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN GRANT AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK **GRANTS:** PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- WHEREAS, The City of Bastrop, Texas (the "City") desires to obtain engineering and surveying services associated with the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

 Program; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to Texas Government Code §2254.004(a)(1) the City must select the most highly qualified provider of those services on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council finds, therefore, that it is reasonable and prudent to issue a Request for Qualifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Bastrop, Texas, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.
- Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to Issue a Request for Qualifications for engineering and surveying services for infrastructure projects.
- Section 3. All orders, ordinances, and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.
- **Section 4.** Should any portion or part of this Resolution be held for any reason invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not be

construed to affect any other valid portion hereof, but all valid portions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

Section 6. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place, and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
