PRIORITIZING MAYFEST PARK TRAIL CONNECTIVITY

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, APPROVING MAKING TRAIL CONNECTIVITY AT MAYFEST PARK A PRIORITY IN THE RECENTLY ADOPTED PARKS MASTER PLAN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, on March 26, 2024, the City of Bastrop, Texas (the "City) passed Resolution R-2024-38 approving the adoption of the previously accepted 2023 City of Bastrop Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan, which includes recommendations to improve the City's trail connectivity; and
- WHEREAS, the City recognizes the growing need for updates and improvements to its trail network to increase connectivity; and
- WHEREAS, the City has determined that the updates and improvements will contribute to the safety, vitality, and attractiveness of the City; and
- WHEREAS, the City has identified Mayfest Park as a priority for trail connectivity updates and improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council of the City of Bastrop, Texas, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.
- Section 2. The City Council approves prioritizing Mayfest Park trail connectivity.
- Section 3. Should any portion or part of this Resolution be held for any reason invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion hereof, but all valid portions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
- **Section 5.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
- Section 6. The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place, and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject

matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
