

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2025-138**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF A GRANT TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) FOR THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY NINE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-FIVE CENTS (\$39,139.55) ALLOWING OFFICERS TO EDUCATE, ENFORCE AND PARTICIPATE IN ON-GOING PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT FOR A SPECIFIED MOBILIZATION PERIOD REGARDING IMPAIRED DRIVERS; AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS THE GRANTS AUTHORIZING OFFICIAL; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Bastrop finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Bastrop and the officers, that the city of Bastrop Police Department apply for a grant from the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for overtime pay at a total cost of Thirty Nine thousand, one hundred and thirty-nine dollars and fifty-five cents (\$39,139.55), with 20% matching funds from the city of Bastrop through fringe benefits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bastrop agrees that the Police Department shall participate in the Impaired Driving Mobilization (IDM) campaign for specified periods of time with the goals of education and enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Bastrop designates the Chief of Police as the Grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, reject, alter, accept, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:**

**Section 1:** The City Council of the City of Bastrop approves the City of Bastrop Police Department's application to the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) for overtime pay for participation in the Impaired Driving Mobilization program

**Section 2:** Any prior resolution of the City Council in conflict with provisions contained in this resolution are hereby repealed and revoked.

**Section 3:** Should any part of this resolution be held to be invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby severable.

**Section 4:** This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is duly resolved.
