

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT TO THE ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 3.08 OF THE CITY CHARTER; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 3.08 of the City Charter provides that the Mayor shall appoint members to all City boards and commissions, subject to confirmation by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a vacancy currently exists on the Zoning Board of Adjustment, and it is necessary to fill such vacancy to ensure the Board can convene and consider pending cases; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has reviewed applications and will appoint a qualified individual to serve on the Zoning Board of Adjustment, with such appointment to be presented to the City Council at the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City to confirm the Mayor's appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Mayor's appointment of **Judith Hoover** to the Zoning Board of Adjustment is hereby confirmed for position #4 to an unexpired term to end May 2027.

Section 2. The term of the appointed member shall be in accordance with the City's Code of Ordinances and applicable policies.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and it is so resolved.
