

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A STREET ROLLER FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS FROM DYNAPAC, A SOURCEWELL CONTRACT VENDOR NO. 060122 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO-HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$214,311.00); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51,001, the City of Bastrop ("City) has general authority to adopt an ordinance, resolution, or police regulation that is for the good, peace, or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bastrop, Texas, has appointed the City Manager as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is responsible for the proper administration of all affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, The purchase will be funded from the Street Operations Fund (110-18-00-6010 Equipment – Capital Outlay) for Street Improvements.

WHEREAS, Dynapac is an approved vendor of the Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative that satisfies competitive procurement and requirements under Texas Law.; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase a street roller from Dynapac through Sourcewell Cooperative Vendor No. 060122; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a purchasing agreement with Dynapac, A Sourcewell Contract Vendor of a not to exceed amount of Two-hundred fourteen thousand three-hundred eleven Dollars and no cents (\$214,311.00).

Section 2. Conflicts with Prior Resolutions: Any prior resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3. Severability: Should any portion or part of this Resolution be held invalid for any reason or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the

same shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion hereof, but all valid portions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

Section 5. Proper Notice & Meeting: The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place, and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered, and formally acted upon, all as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.
