

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-2025-113 REGARDING CERTAIN RULES OF PROCEDURE AND POLICIES FOR CITY COUNCIL AND THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR; REMOVING THE TIME LIMIT FOR CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS' USE OF THE COUNCIL EXECUTIVE CONFERENCE ROOM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-2025-113 establishing certain rules of procedure and policies regarding City Council and the Office of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Section 1, Subsection 3 of Resolution No. R-2025-113 to remove the limitation on the amount of time City Council Members and the Mayor may utilize the Council Executive Conference Room; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that allowing continued shared use of the Council Executive Conference Room without a specified hourly limitation remains in the best interest of the City and will continue to support the conduct of municipal business while maintaining the room's primary use for executive sessions and conference purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

Section 1, Subsection 3 of Resolution No. R-2025-113 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"City Council members, including the Mayor, may utilize the Council Executive Conference Room as a shared office space. The space shall continue to be used for executive sessions and be configured as a conference room."

SECTION 2.

All other provisions of Resolution No. R-2025-113 not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.


