

RESOLUTION NO. R-2026-97

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS APPROVING CHANGE ORDER #5 TO THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH JAY-REESE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF OLD IRON BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$300,000.00); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop approved Resolution No. R-2025-82 entering into a construction contract with Jay-Reese Contractors, Inc. on April 29, 2025, for the construction of Old Iron Bridge Rehabilitation project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager authorized Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Services Agreement with Huitt-Zollars for design and construction phase services associated with the addition of RGB lighting to the existing three trusses as part of the Old Iron Bridge Rehabilitation project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed RGB lighting system is intended to enhance the appearance of the Old Iron Bridge and provide the ability to illuminate the bridge in various colors to commemorate community events, holidays, and other special occasions; and

WHEREAS, Jay-Reese Contractors, Inc. has submitted a cost proposal for the associated construction of the proposed improvements; and

WHEREAS, Change Order #5 provides for the addition of RGB lighting to the existing three trusses as part of the Old Iron Bridge Rehabilitation project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop City Council finds that the proposed change order is an appropriate use of project contingency funds, and that sufficient contingency remains available for future project needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Change Order #5 with Jay-Reese Contractors, Inc. in the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$300,000.00) as part of the Old Iron Bridge Rehabilitation Project.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is duly resolved.

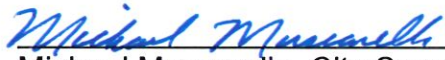

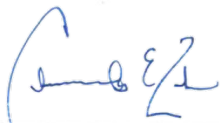
