RESOLUTION NO. R-2017-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TX AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MONITORING WELL AND A 1,500 GALLON PER MINUTE PRODUCTION WELL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 668,539 TO BRIEN WATER WELLS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF THE MONITORING AND PRODUCTION WELL HENCEFORWARD KNOW AS WELL SITE (J); AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council has appointed the City Manager as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City Manager is responsible for the proper administration of all affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, The City Council approved the contract for design of a new production well to secure an adequate water supply, and maintain the health and safety of our community; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has the steadfastness to ensure a quality water source is developed for future generations; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bastrop has received all bids, and found the lowest responsible bidder to be qualified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the construction of Wellsite J and all ancillary components in the amount of \$251,170.

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Bastrop has found Brien Water Wells to be the lowest responsible bidder.

<u>Section 3:</u> All orders, ordinances, and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Resolution shall be and remain controlling as to the matters resolved herein.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage, and it is so resolved.
