A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS, APPROVING THE BASTROP POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A GRANT FOR TWENTY (20) RIFLE-RESISTANT BALLISTIC VESTS AT A TOTAL COST OF THIRTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIVE AND 06/100 DOLLARS (\$13,605.06) FROM THE 2018 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM WITH NO MATCHING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF BASTROP; AUTHORIZING PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR AS THE GRANTEE'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Bastrop, that the Bastrop Police Department utilize a grant that has been awarded to them from the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program for twenty rifle-resistant ballistic vests at a total cost of \$13,605.06 with no matching funds from the City of Bastrop; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant, the City of Bastrop City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the State Homeland Security Grant Program in full; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bastrop designates Public Safety Director James K. Altgelt as the Grantee's authorized official. The authorize official is given the power to apply for, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BASTROP, TEXAS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Bastrop approves acceptance of the grant award for the Bastrop Police Department's 2018 Homeland Security Grant Program and designates the Public Safety Director as the Grantee's authorized official.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Any prior resolution of the City Council in conflict with the provisions contained in this resolution are hereby repealed and revoked.
- <u>Section 3:</u> Should any part of this resolution be held to be invalid for any reason, the remainder shall not be affected thereby, and such remaining portions are hereby severable.
- **Section 4:** This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is duly resolved.
