

Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Bastrop will receive sealed bids for the Water Street & Linden Street Sanitary Sewer Pipe Bursting Project until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 31, 2026 at the temporary offices of City Hall, 1311 Chestnut Street, in Bastrop, Texas 78602. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 31, 2026 at said office.

Bids are invited for the Water Street & Linden Street Sanitary Sewer Pipe Bursting Project as described in the specifications, including pipe bursting 4" and 6" wastewater lines, open cut remove & replace wastewater lines, manholes, services, pavement repair, and associated appurtenances.

A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid, issued by an acceptable surety, shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Bastrop or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age or national origin.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City for a period not to exceed seventy (70) consecutive calendar days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

Basis of award will be to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder who provides goods or services using the following criteria:

- the proposal price, including alternate and additive/deductive alternate bids;
- the historical quality of the bidder's goods or services; and
- the bidder's past responsible performance, safety and working relationship with the city and other entities.
