THE MAIN STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT

1. Where can I find out more general information about the Project?

2. Where can I go for ongoing Project updates?

3. What does the Project entail?

The City is either replacing, expanding, or building sidewalks from Main Street and Farm Street down to Main Street and Water Street at Ferry Park. We are increasing landscaping, lighting, trashcans, and benches. We will also be redoing the roadway for a portion of that expanse.

4. Will we be losing parking spots?

Main Street gains parking spots from Pine Street down to Water Street. Parking from Spring Street to Chestnut Street changes from diagonal to parallel producing one lost spot on the East and West side but overall, the Project provides a net gain of 30+ parking spots.

5. I got a door hanger on my door - what does it mean?

Four different door hanger designs convey different information. Please see the types listed below:

 Partnership Meeting: This means you have a Partnership Meeting with Project Liaisons at City Hall on the date and time listed to go over the details of the project impact for your construction cycle. Please note that it means that there is upcoming construction on your half of the block so if you cannot make the meeting, please reach out to the Project Liaisons via email or phone.

- Sidewalk Improvements: This means that you have upcoming construction occurring on either your side or the other side of your block. The date is on the door hanger.
- Improvement Impact: This means that the construction crew will be in front of your door on the date listed on the door hanger.
- Roadway Improvements: This means that we will be working on the roads in front of your address on the date listed on the door hanger.
