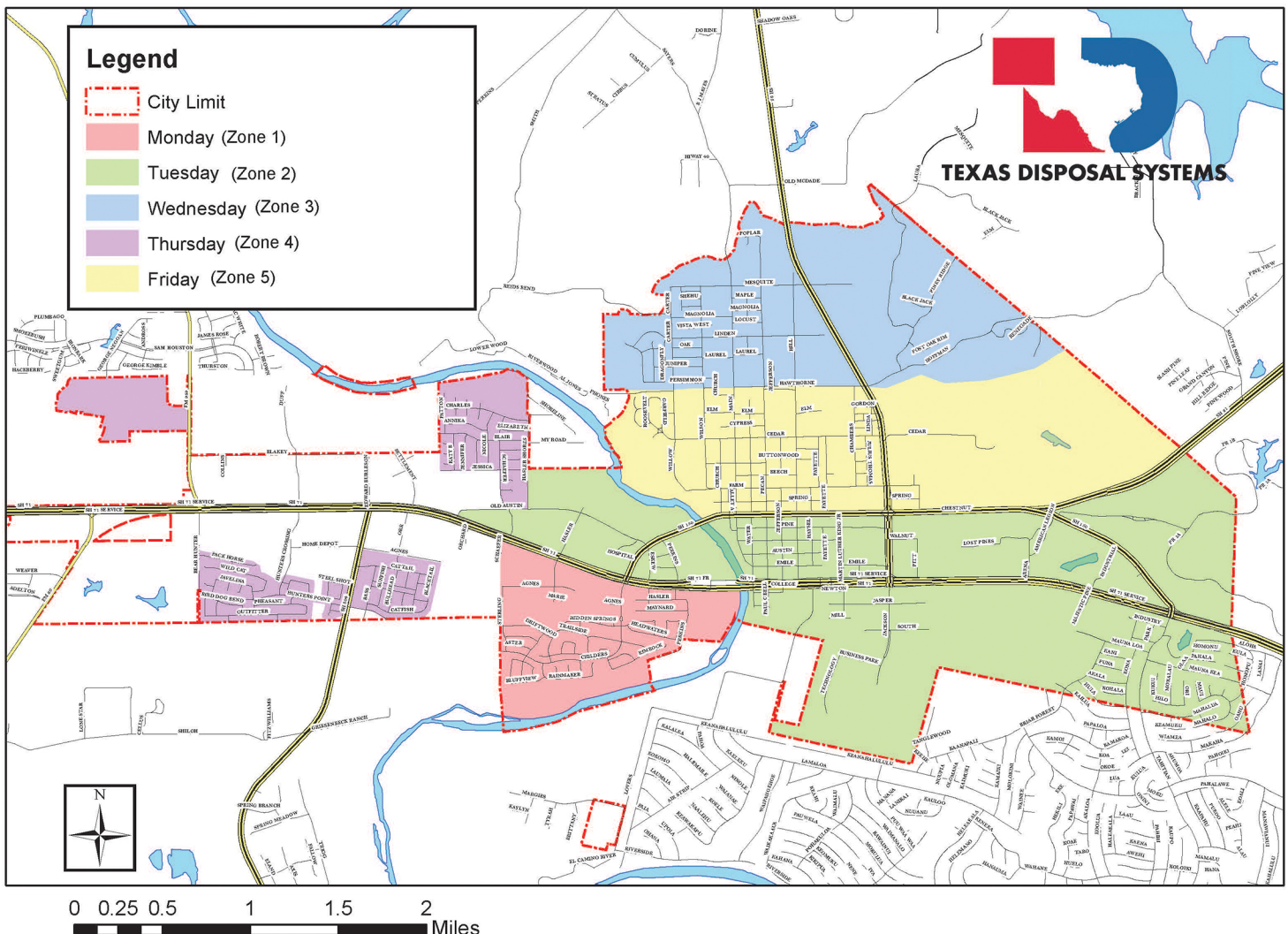
The City of Bastrop has a new solid waste provider! Texas Disposal Systems will service all residential and commercial accounts beginning the first week of September 2024.

We are excited to announce that beginning September 1, 2024, Texas Disposal Systems (TDS) will be the new Solid Waste and Recycling Services Provider for the City of Bastrop.

TDS services will begin the first week of September. Please note, your current trash or recycling pickup day may be changing. For specific details on your new schedule, see map below, recycling schedule on the opposite side of this page or visit cityofbastrop.org/pickup. The last collection with your current service provider will take place during the week of August 26, 2024. On your current pickup day during that week, please leave your old carts at the curb to be collected by Waste Connections. We are here to make this transition smooth and easy for you.

City of Bastrop Residential Trash & Recycle Service Days



- Your trash and recycling pickup day occur on the same day of the week. Trash collection happens every week and recycling collection is every other week.
- Pickup is limited to your cart only. Recycling collection includes bundled cardboard tied with twine or packing tape, placed outside your cart. No additional bags permitted.
- TDS does not accept hazardous materials, non-compactable materials, dirt, concrete or construction materials.

Bulky & Brush Service Information:

- City of Bastrop residents receive bulky pickup every week on trash collection day.
 - Each collection is limited to the greater of one item or a maximum of four (4) cubic yards per household.
- Bulky pickup includes materials not easily contained in a bag such as, but not limited to, furniture, mattresses and box springs, carpets and rugs, lawn equipment (drained of oil and gas), large toys, large appliances, and yard trimmings in bags or bundles.
- Yard waste must be bundled, tied and cut into four (4) foot lengths with cut ends facing the curb. Limbs must be 6 inches or less in diameter.
