FREE Youth Disc Golf Clinic

Disc golf is played much like golf. Instead of a ball and clubs, though, players use a flying disc or Frisbee®. The sport was formalized in the 1970s and shares with golf the object of completing each hole in the fewest strokes (or, in the case of disc golf, fewest throws).

The City of Bastrop has a beautiful new Disc Golf Course in Bob Bryant Park! Beginning October 5th the recreation program will be hosting a free youth disc golf clinic. Youth ages 8 to 14 will learn the basics of disc golf and how to play the game. Disc golf provides both physical and mental exercise while having fun. Come out and learn this lifetime sport!
