



Discovery is a program that gives youth, ages 7 to 12, an opportunity to seek, explore and DISCOVER!! It might be an experiment, an art project or anything in between, but there is always a "take away" and an opportunity to learn and have fun! It is offered every 2nd and 4th Mondays at 4:30pm.

September 12 – “Light Science”

We will look at what mirrors, lenses, and prisms do with light. AND, we will make kaleidoscopes!

September 26 – “Leaf Painting”

We will be painting tree leaves with interesting patterns and colors using acrylic paint.

October 10 – “Paper Microscopes” – We will build microscopes from paper and use them to take a close look at some very small things.

October 24 – “Masks for Dia de los Muertos (sugar skull masks)”

Kids will cut out and decorate sugar skull masks with markers. They will also be taught the history of this important day!

November 14 – “What Makes a Magnet Magnetic?” – Some things are magnetic, and others are not. Sometimes magnets attract and sometimes they don’t. Come and find out why.

November 28 – “Folded Paper Christmas Ornaments”

Pre-designed templates for folded paper ornaments will allow the kids to create one-of-a-kind ornaments to take home and put on their tree. They will be guided through the cutting, folding, and decorating of these ornaments.

December 12 – “Symmetry, Geometry & Fractions in Art” – We will find the math in important works of art, paintings, photography, and music. We will also play with spirographs and make some art of our own.

December 26 – “Paper Mosaic”

Kids will make a mosaic with construction paper, creating a design using the first letter of their name or a simple drawing.
