

## MEP Trade Permit Checklist

## **Trade Permit Process Overview**

- 1. Complete Trade Credentials and upload required insurance/license documents at https://web.mygov.us
- 2. Complete Trade Application information fields and upload required documents at <a href="https://web.mygov.us">https://web.mygov.us</a> for the permit
- 3. Staff Approval or Denial of request
  - a. If denied, please see the Items Required for the reasons for the denial within permit on MyGov
- 4. Applicant pays any/all fees for the permit
- 5. Permit will be issued after approval and all fees are paid
- 6. Inspections are requested by contractors as progress is made towards the final inspection. See Inspection Procedures for instructions.
