

**BASTROP MUNICIPAL COURT STANDING ORDERS**

**STANDING ORDER XVIII: WARRANT AMNESTY PROGRAM**

**IT IS ORDERED** during the City of Bastrop's "Warrant Amnesty Program", running from March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, through March 31st, 2026, that defendants with open cases be given safe harbor when visiting the municipal court clerk's office or appearing at an open court hearing to take care of their outstanding warrants.

**IT IS ORDERED** that defendants who pay their citations that are in active arrest warrant(s) status in full or pays a minimum of one-half (1/2) the total amount due and starts a payment plan for the balance owed, shall be eligible to have all warrant fees waived. Defendants who pay their citations that are in active arrest warrant(s) status in full may have an additional seventy-five percent (75%) of the fine amount waived. Defendants who pay half of their citations in active arrest warrant(s) status may have an additional fifty percent (50%) of the fine amount waived; the remaining balance will be placed on a payment plan of \$50 a month until paid in full. The Warrant Amnesty Program shall not waive any portion of the court costs or collection fees.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that these standing orders are to serve as guidelines for clerks in the Judge's absence during the Warrant Amnesty Program. These orders shall expire on March 31st, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.
